Founded and based in Houston, Texas, **Deux Voix** represents one of the most cherished and historical combinations of musical sounds, and has transformed it to appeal to a wide range of audiences.

Stephen and Justin have amassed a significant amount of success and a rapidly growing reputation performing across the country. They have performed in Georgetown, Houston, and Missouri City, Texas as well as the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota, Myers Park United Methodist in Charlotte, North Carolina, Philadelphia and Lancaster, Pennsylvania, and Port Angeles, Washington for the Washington Music Festival. They also presented a wildly successful headlining program for the L'Organo Series at the Piccolo Spoleto Festival in Charleston, South Carolina in May 2015, where they performed the formal dedication concert for the new organ at The Citadel, and set a new record for the largest crowd for in the over thirty-year history of the series. They were also featured in the American Guild of Organists magazine, detailing their performance in Charleston.

Upcoming events for *Deux Voix* include a concert and lecture in Duluth, Minnesota for the American Guild of Organists, an organ dedication concert for St. Anthony of Padua Catholic Church in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, and a Northeast tour in August, including concerts at St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City, the Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul in Lewiston, Maine and the Ogunquit Baptist Church in Ogunquit, Maine. The duo will also be traveling back to Washington to perform in Seattle and Port Angeles in the fall.

Stephen Distad, currently the Music Associate and Organist at Memorial Drive United Methodist Church, is a nationally recognized organist and church musician. Before coming to Houston, he served as Minister of Music at First Baptist Church in Charleston, SC, Director of Music at Christ United Methodist Church in Rochester, MN, and Organist at First United Methodist Church in Shreveport, LA. Stephen has performed in numerous notable and historical locations such as St. Thomas Episcopal in New York, St. Patrick's Cathedral in Dublin, and Notre Dame in Paris. He received his Bachelor's Degree from Drake University, his Master's from Baylor University, and post-graduate studies at the Eastman School of Music. Stephen also studied under Marie-Claire Alain at the Conservatoire de Rueill-Malmaisison in Paris.

Justin Langham is an active freelance musician, composer, arranger, and teacher in Houston. Originally from Mobile, AL, Justin earned a double Bachelor's degree in Trumpet Performance and Composition from the University of Alabama in Tuscaloosa, and earned his Masters in Trumpet Performance at

the University of Houston. He is a member of the Houston Civic Symphony and has performed frequently with the Houston Ballet Orchestra. An avid educator, Mr. Langham maintains an active private teaching studio with students around the greater Houston area, and is Adjunct Professor of Music Theory at Lone Star College Montgomery. He is also the Director of Music Ministries at Grace United Methodist Church in Houston.

As a composer and arranger, Justin has written for all instrumentations in all styles. Notable pieces include his *Concertino for Euphonium* was premiered by prominent soloist Kyohei Ando in Tokyo, Japan in 2013, as well as *Grove Divine*, an organ suite written for Mr. Distad in 2015.
